MY PERFECT DAY

The model, influencer and founder of Rama Voyage on the joys of a sleep-in and bacon and eggs in Bali

9.00AM If I'm dreaming about a perfect day, it would definitely involve a sleep-in. That's incredibly rare because I usually have to get up at six, or I'm woken up during the night, so to have a full night's sleep and wake up around nine would be absolute bliss.

11.00AM We go to Ku De Ta for brunch, which is a thing on Sundays in Bali. They have a kids' theme park happening there, and always, always I have scrambled eggs with bacon. They've got the best bacon on the island. I love bacon! The kids do too.

1.00PM The afternoon is hanging out at home with the kids. We always have family dance-offs, but my perfect day would probably involve the music I want to play, something very chilled. Then I'll probably read a magazine — ideally *Harper's BAZAAR!* — while sunbaking. I don't ever sunbake in Bali unless I'm at the beach because I'm always with the kids, so a perfect day would actually involve some sun time and being able to lounge uninterrupted.

3.00PM We go to the beach for a good long session. We all drink coconuts and watch the waves, and the kids usually have spicy corn or sweet corn from the beach vendors. It might come with a touch of Bali belly, but that's fine. That's normal!

5.00PM I love a bit of self-pampering. I've got this local place where I go most days to get what they call a cream bath. They put all this protein treatment in your hair and they give you a massive scalp, head, back and shoulder massage for an hour, and it's literally \$10. I get that done and then I get a mani/pedi and the kids will often have one too. It's so nice because we're all sitting there relaxing together. We usually do that on a weekend.

6.00PM It's time for a little nanna nap and then sunset cocktails somewhere with Adam [Lindy's husband, Adam Ellis]. It's hard because Bali's become so popular that you actually have to go to a resort to get on the beach and get a good cocktail, otherwise you might end up with arak, the rice wine! We either go into Seminyak for cocktails, or La Lucciola on the beach is really nice. If we're going out for dinner after, there are so many beautiful restaurants to choose from to have a special meal. — *As told to Georgina Safe*
